

- Club Sponsors and Mentors

*Sponsor: A Sponsor is a Toastmaster who organizes and helps to charter a new Toastmasters club. Each new club may have one or two Sponsors. Each sponsor receives a certificate from TI and credit toward Advanced Leader certification. To receive credit as a Sponsor, the member's name must appear on the Application to Organize and the Club President must notify TI in writing that the Sponsor has fulfilled his/her responsibilities.*

*Mentor: A mentor is a Toastmaster who assists a new club for at least six months after chartering, helping it through the first critical months. Each new club may have one or two Mentors. The mentor receives a certificate from TI, and credit toward Advanced Leader certification. To receive credit as a Mentor, the member's name must appear on the Application to Organize, and six months after chartering, the Club President must notify TI in writing that the Mentor has fulfilled his/her responsibilities.*

Marketing Team members will have opportunities to serve as a club Sponsor or Mentor, which fulfills another portion of the requirement for Advanced Leader certification. District 28 club members who provide a new club prospect and wish to be involved in the club's formation will be added to a team. Toastmasters wishing to be a Sponsor or Mentor this year will need to be part of the Marketing Team.

If you are interested, but don't know how, we'll teach you! Marketing Trainers, individuals with solid backgrounds as a Mentor and/or Sponsor, and in conducting demonstration meetings, will serve as trainers for the Marketing Team.
